Frequent Flyers™ Productions (FFP) Aerial Dance School has a limited number of work-study opportunities available. Students can apply based on financial need and merit. The work-study program offers partial tuition for classes (excluding private lessons and guest workshops) in exchange for working at the studio a set number of hours.

This application must be filled out in its entirety and a face to face interview scheduled with the Assistant Education Director. A parent/guardian needs to attend the interview if applicant is under 18 years of age. Return completed application to:

Students who wish to participate in the Work Study Program must agree to the following terms:

- 1) Students may only charge fifty percent (50%) of their class tuition to work study hours. The 50% balance on classes for which the student is earning work-study tuition credit must be paid at the beginning of each session once the student has been approved for work-study.
- 2) Negative account balances cannot be carried over into the next session. If a student's work-study hours are not sufficient to cover the charges, it is the student's responsibility to pay any remaining monies owed before being allowed to enroll in additional coursework.
- 3) Students will be required to organize scheduling with the Assistant Education Director prior to completing any work-study hours. Additionally, work-study must be done under the supervision of a Frequent Flyers staff member.
- 4) Students will receive credit at a rate of \$10/hour. Credit for work-study hours will be made weekly and applied to any outstanding balance. It is the responsibility of the Assistant Education Director and the student to maintain accurate records of hours worked and jobs completed.
