What is StudCo and who is it for?

Frequent Flyers Student Company is for enthusiastic students willing to grow as aerialists, dancers, artists, performers, and team members. Students should have a strong desire to learn more about the art of aerial

dance and the have the ability to be a focused, positive presence in classes and rehearsals.

Frequent Flyers Student Company will present its 19th season in Fall 2019, with professional-quality performances at the Dairy Center for the Arts in Boulder.

MISSION: The Frequent Flyers® Student Company is a supportive community fostering creative aerial dance performance opportunities while empowering the individual to embody confidence in their artistic and technical abilities. Embedded in a safe, supportive, non-competitive environment, students can soar in their artistic expression, connecting the ground and the air.

PERFORMANCE THEME: The theme for this performance is *Musical Legends!*

Participation Requirements

Prerequisites: Each company member must be age 8-18 and is required to have completed two FFP aerial sessions prior to joining Student Company. Please email Alysha@frequentflyers.org if you have any questions about qualifying.

You will be notified of your acceptance by Tuesday, July 30th.

Required Classes

Each company member is required to attend:

- Student Company class on Wednesdays
- 1 aerial technique class each session, both Fall 1 and Fall 2- You may take different technique classes each session.
- 1 session of Dance, which take place on Wednesdays from 6:15-7:15pm (This will be an assigned class.)

Absentee Policy

- Mandatory Theater Rehearsals include Tech/Dress/Performances at the Frequent Flyers
 Studio and/or at The Dairy Arts Center (dates listed above). If student has a conflict
 with a mandatory rehearsal, the guardian / student must report that conflict in
 their application and contract, and must email Alysha Perrin
 (alysha@frequentflyers.org) by Monday, August 26, 2019. Excused absences will be
 considered under special circumstances, and only if requested by August 26th.
- Mandatory Rehearsals include all Wednesday Student Company classes at Frequent Flyers. No unexcused absences are allowed. Each Student Company Member is allowed 2 excused absences for the Fall semester. An absence is only considered excused if you have contacted the office prior to the date of the absence. If a student misses more than 2 rehearsals, it is up to the Student Company Director's discretion whether or not to exclude the student from (1) aerial work in a piece, (2) all choreography in a particular piece or (3) the entire show. This requirement exists for your student's safety, as well as the safety of the students they are performing with. Students missing a mandatory rehearsal on short notice should contact the Education Director, Alysha Perrin (alysha@frequentflyers.org) and your student's instructors as soon as possible before the missed class.

Behavior

- One of the main priorities for StudCo is to create an inclusive atmosphere where
 everyone feels safe and encouraged to play and to develop their aerial technique and
 expression. Please be mindful of this goal in all of your interactions at Frequent Flyers,
 including within your / your child's StudCo classes. As StudCo members, you / your child
 have the opportunity to be role models on this front! Help us create a positive
 environment.
- In addition to absences, the Student Company Director may dismiss a student at any
 time from the piece/performance/Student Company if problems with the policies stated in
 the Student Company contract or Frequent Flyers Aerial Dance Handbook persist or the
 presence of an issue is detected that is considered inappropriate for the well being of the
 Student Company.

There WILL BE a final class on 12/18.

Additionally, we will have two full-cast rehearsals <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>November 20th and Wednesday</u>, <u>December 4th from 4:30-9pm</u> (with a dinner break). These full-cast rehearsals are mandatory.

Parent Information/ Social Night: Please join us during the second week of Student Company on Wednesday, September 4th from 5:45-6:15 in Studio 1 to learn more information about what it means to be a part of studeo, meet other studeo parents, and ask any questions you may have.

Student Company Social Time

Wednesday nights from 5:45-6:15pm the students have a break between classes. This is a great time not only for snacks or dinner, but also a built in block for social time. Spending time together outside of class helps the students get to know one another, build community, and have fun! Do note that we are not able to provide formal child care during this time. There will be staff in the office and/or teachers in the studios. If you feel comfortable with your child being at the studio without formal supervision, then we encourage you to let them stay at this time to spend some time with their fellow company members.

Financial Commitment & Payment Options

This year, Student Company will be tuition based per semester. Fall semester tuition cost is \$1000. This tuition includes payment for all of your required classes for both sessions, as well as your production fee. You have 2 options for payment. See below.

- 1. Make one payment at the beginning of the semester and get 5% off the total cost, bringing your total to \$950. This payment is due upon receipt of the contract.
- 2. My card will be charged the \$175 production fee upon receiving this contract, and \$206.25 each subsequent month of the Fall semester on the 1st of each month, with the final payment being assessed in December 2019. You must provide a credit card on your MindBody account to select this option, and the charges will be set up through auto-pay.
- 3. Work Study/Scholarship Option- As a non-profit organization, Frequent Flyers does not wish cost to be a prohibiting factor for students interested in participating in Student Company. All students may apply for scholarship funding and those who are 12-years-of-age or older may apply for Work Study. Work Study and scholarship applications may be requested from and are due to Education Director, Alysha Perrin (alysha@frequentflyers.org) by Wednesday, July 24th.

NOTE: If you must drop out of Student Company after the start of the season on Wednesday, August 28th, the \$175 production fee is non-refundable.

*As a Student Company member, you may purchase additional session classes at 20% off the full price.

Photo/Video

Professional photos and video will be taken of the show. This season the cost for both the photos and video are included in your production fee. You will receive photos and video via email as quickly as they are edited and given to us.

D. Communication

Your instructors, the Student Company Director, and the Education Team want you / your child to feel comfortable voicing your joys, concerns, and confusion to us! Your instructors are available during class time to help the students sort through any choreography- and show-related issues. If you'd like to share feedback or concerns, please feel free to catch up with the teachers after class or email the Student Company Director, Sarah Harrison, at Sarah@frequentflyers.org or Alysha Perrin at Alysha@frequentflyers.org. Sarah and Alysha will also communicate with StudCo members and parents/guardians primarily through email to relay any important information about assignments, supplies, costumes, performance details, scheduling, etc. In most instances, they will include the student and the parent(s)/guardian(s) on these emails. When possible, please give the student an opportunity to respond and further develop their sense of personal responsibility. Depending on the age of the child, it may be more appropriate for the parent/guardian to respond. It is important that you and/or your child check your email regularly and respond within a few days, and it is ultimately the parent(s)/guardian(s)'s responsibility to make sure you have received the information.
